What do you need to get started?

- A PC computer running Windows[®] 2000 or XP
- An Internet connection
- Microsoft Internet Explorer[®] 6.0 or higher(selected courses in Calculus and Statistics also work with supported versions of Netscape; got to <http://www.mathxl.com/support/system.htm> for details)
- A MathXL Student Access Code. **This code is printed inside the Student Access Kit that will be distributed on March 27th in Prof. Barsamian's Math 163A lecture. This kit is free for Prof. Barsamian's class.**
- Your instructor's name and the name of your course (**Mark Barsamian, 2007 Spring Math 163A Section 06**).

What steps do I take next?

- 1) Go to www.mathxl.com & click the **Register** button.

- 2) Leave **No, I Am a New User** selected and enter your six-word student access code, zip code and country.
- 3) Fill in the requested personal information, and then create your unique Login Name and Password. It's recommended that you use your email address as your login name.
- 4) **Very important note: When you are prompted to enter your First Name, Last Name, and e-mail address, it is essential that you use the exact same data that the Ohio University Registrar uses for you in the official rosters. This data is printed on the label that Prof. Barsamian put on the front of your Student Access Kit. Enter the information exactly as it is printed on the label.**
- 5) Follow the on-screen instructions to complete your registration.
- 6) Go to www.mathxl.com, enter the login name and password you created during registration, and click the **Enter** button.
- 7) Click the **Enroll in a New Course** button.
- 8) The first time you log in to MathXL, you need to enroll in your instructor's online course.
 - Select "Enroll in my instructor's course" and then choose your school, instructor, and course name from the drop-down menus. (**Ohio University, Mark Barsamian, 2007 Spring Math 163A Section 06**)
- 9) Click the **Enroll** button.
- 10) Click the **Run installation wizard now** button to install necessary software on your computer. You must run the Installation Wizard before using MathXL. (**Note:** The software may already be installed in the school lab. Check with your lab administrator.)
- 11) After running the Installation Wizard, close your Internet Browser.
- 12) Open your Internet browser again and log back into MathXL at www.mathxl.com. You can now start working in your MathXL course!
